Minimum Entry Criteria:

- Be 18 years of age
- NZ Aviation Class 1 medical
- Competency in spoken and written English - Overseas students (IELTS Band 6.0)
- NCEA level 3 or
 - Trade qualification
 - PPL exams
- Fit & Proper Person
- Demonstrate ability to complete entire programme
- Previous experience in aviation would be an advantage
- All applicants will need to undertake a pre screening online Pilot Aptitude test. Thereafter suitable applicants will be invited to an interview.
